



Mr. Milard Herweck was admitted to hospital following Pain and falls resulting from osteoarthritis resulting L hip surgery., He has a history hernia; spondylosis of cervical joint; SOB; hx. of congestive heart failure; hyperlipidemia; HTN; CAD; GERD; hx of DVT; congestive heart failure; cardiac dysrhythmia. Mr. Herweck post-surgery discharged to Silver Springs SNF on 7/27/24 to receive skilled therapy.

PT evaluated on 07/29/24 and they noted that he needed skilled PT to improve strength, endurance, functional mobility, transfers, balance, and gait. Following 20 visits, He was able to transition from the SNF to home with increased independence. Mr. Herweck during his time on therapy services he demonstrated the following skills: sit to stand from Max A to Supervision, with functional transfers for chair <-> bed from Max A. to Sup, his Gait at admit was less than 50ft CGA w/ Walker at time of discharge was able to ambulate 150+ ft w/ FWW at Supervision level, , he was able to manage a 1 step curb with Supervision, and at time of discharge he was able to maintain up to 10 steps up and down with Supervision and use of rails.

OT evaluated Mr. Herweck on 7/29/24 and they found he needed skilled OT to improve his range of motion, for strengthening, for fine and gross motor control, Balance, Safety, and energy conservation. Mr. Herweck demonstrated during his time on therapy services the following skills: improved toileting hygiene from requiring Max A to Sup ,with his upper body dressing he went from Min A to Independent, and lower body dressing from Max A to Set up, his ability with donning and doffing Shoes went from Max A to Set Up and bathing skills from Mod A.to Supervision.

With these functional improvements from skilled Nursing, PT and OT services, he was successfully discharged home with spouse, where resident will participate in Home health therapy services to maintain progress with continued active participation in daily activities and community ambulation.





MDS Section GG Functional Scores

06 - Independent

Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper $\,$

05- Setup or clean-up assistance

Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

04 - Supervision or touching assistance

 $Helper\ provides\ verbal\ cues\ and/or\ touching/steadying\ and/or\ contact\ guard$

assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided

throughout the activity or intermittently.

03 - Partial/moderate assistance

 $\label{thm:elliptic_loss} \textit{Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. } \textit{Helper lifts, holds, or supports}$

trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

02 - Substantial/maximal assistance

Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk

or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

01 - Dependent

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to

complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
